This letter came to me this week and I would like to share it with you in lieu of "my letter".

Dear Father Durkee:

On behalf of the staff, Board of Trustees, and the hundreds of homeowners we serve throughout Summit County each year, I want to thank you for your congregations support of Rebuilding Together. Since 1995, Rebuilding Together has assisted more than 1300 Summit County homeowners remain safe, warm, and dry in their homes. With the average income of our clients about \$14,700, those we serve are often on the precipice of losing their home, are at a great risk of falling or illness without the financial ability to address those challenges themselves. 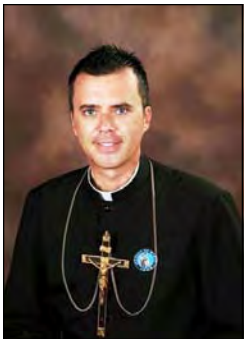

Reverend Menezes, CPM, is a member of the Fathers of Mercy, based in Auburn, Kentucky, with focus on preaching and presenting parish missions and retreats, and assisting and staffing rural parishes. Since his ordination in 2000, he has served the Congregation as Director of Vocations and Director of Seminarians. Reverend Menezes also served as the Chaplain-in-Residence at the Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament of Our Lady of the Angels Monastery in Hanceville, Alabama, both affiliated with EWTN.

Reverend Menezes has been a contributing writer to a number of publications, including *National Catholic Register* and *Our Sunday Visitor*. Several of his homiletic series have been published in the *Homiletic and Pastoral Review*, an international journal for priests. His presentations have been featured on radio stations of EWTN, Voice of Virtue International and Ave Maria Radio. He has been a guest on EWTN’s *Mother Angelica Live* and *Life on the Rock* programs. He has hosted three television series for EWTN, covering topics such as the commandments of Catholic family living, that is, for husband and father; for wife and mother; of children and teens; and for those who struggle with scrupulosity. He is currently host of the EWTN series entitled *The Crux of the Matter*.
