**NOTES FROM FATHER DAVE...**

Dear Friends,

Have you ever asked yourself the question, why am I a Catholic, why do I remain a Catholic? Perhaps you do and perhaps you answer it like this: Because I like the music here at Queen of Heaven. Perhaps because of our love for Mary, or we have a Pope. But I would like to say, the main reason I am a Catholic and remain a Catholic is because of our belief in the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. That has been our teaching from the very first Mass offered when Jesus said, "This is my Body, This is my Blood." Not a symbol or a sign, but truly is Jesus Christ!

Does this teaching really affect your life? Does it make you want to *never* miss Mass on a weekend? Does it draw you to want to make visits in our Chapel or our Church? I hope that it does! We are all touched by the real presence of Jesus, in different ways and times. I can remember back in the 5th grade, to prepare us for 40 Hours (Eucharistic Devotions), Sr. Pius had all the boys stay after school for two weeks to learn the song "The Pange Lingua - "Sing my tongue the Savior's Glory". We led the procession with the Blessed Sacrament, singing "The Pange Lingua", dressed in red cassocks and fancy surpluses. With all the candles and incense it made a lasting impression that this truly is My Lord and My God...and we pulled out all the stops for Him.

Next Sunday, January 31st at the 11am Mass we will have a similar procession and begin our 3 days of Solemn Eucharistic Devotions, closing with Vespers and a Pasta Dinner for all on Tuesday at 6pm. Please commit now to an hour of prayer during these 3 days (sign ups are in the Gathering Space) and we are counting on a full church for the Vespers at 6pm Tuesday. Fr. Matthew Pfeiffer (a newly ordained) from St. Sebastian's will be preaching.

Wishing to highlight the "Year of Priests" as designated by Pope Benedict XVI to be June 2009-June 2010, the first movie is scheduled for Saturday, January 30 at 6:30-8:30 pm. It is about Father Damien, the leper priest, who was newly canonized October 11, 2009 as Saint Damien of Molokai. Belgium-born Jozef de Veuster, 1840-1889, and known in religious life as Father Damien, joined the Sacred Heart Fathers in 1860 and was sent to Hawaii in 1864. After nine years of mission work on the main island, he volunteered to serve the lepers on the Island of Molokai where he died a leper. Free popcorn and pop will be provided.
