**NOTES FROM FATHER DAVE...**

Dear Friends,

"The word of the Lord came to me saying: Before I formed you in the womb I knew you." Jeremiah 1:4 Those words we hear in today's first reading. These words should all be familiar to us here at Queen of Heaven. They are the words inscribed on our beautiful Pro-Life monument to the left of our main entrance to the Church. They were the words I saw a week ago Friday (on January 22nd at the March for Life in D.C.) inscribed on so many banners. They are the words that should be inscribed upon our hearts, to motivate us to keep standing up "for Life". That all human life is sacred from conception to natural death.

What a refreshing sight it was to concelebrate Mass with several bishops and priests in a filled church at The National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception to pray at our Lady's Shrine for an end to the evil of abortion. To walk with 1/2 million down Constitution Avenue to be a voice for the voiceless. What an awesome sight it was to see. The crowd was primarily youth...my generation didn't quite get it. The youth will turn it around to a culture of life I do believe. Maybe next year we can get a whole bus load from Queen of Heaven to be part of that March, (anybody want to help me with that idea?). Maybe there will be no need next year for a March...if enough pray. Some demons can only be expelled by prayer and fasting.

Speaking of prayer, this weekend we kick off three days of prayer before the Eucharist in our Annual Solemn Eucharistic Devotion. If you have yet to sign up for an hour, please do so in the Gathering Space. Adoration will be in the Church after the 11am Mass on Sunday thru Tuesday 6pm Vesper Service. (Our chapel will be closed those hours.) Hope to see a good turn out for those hours of adoration and especially for the closing Vesper Service followed by a Pasta Dinner for all in the PLC.

Of other things:

Many thanks to all for your generosity in the past 2 weeks at the 2nd collections. Nearly \$6,000 was collected for Haiti Relief and \$2,100 for Rebuilding Together.

A reminder this Tuesday is the feast of The Presentation of the Lord, often called Candlemas Day. A Mass at 8:30am, Adoration all day and Vesper Service with a Candlelight procession will help mark this awesome feast.

Wednesday is the feast of St. Blaise. It is customary to have our throats blessed that day. An extra Mass at 6:30pm has been added. The throat blessing will take place at both the 8:30am and the 6:30pm Masses.

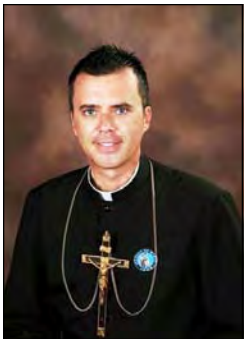

Reverend Menezes, CPM, is a member of the Fathers of Mercy, based in Auburn, Kentucky, with focus on preaching and presenting parish missions and retreats, and assisting and staffing rural parishes. Since his ordination in 2000, he has served the Congregation as Director of Vocations and Director of Seminarians. Reverend Menezes also served as the Chaplain-in-Residence at the Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament of Our Lady of the Angels Monastery in Hanceville, Alabama, both affiliated with EWTN.

Reverend Menezes has been a contributing writer to a number of publications, including *National Catholic Register* and *Our Sunday Visitor*. Several of his homiletic series have been published in the *Homiletic and Pastoral Review*, an international journal for priests. His presentations have been featured on radio stations of EWTN, Voice of Virtue International and Ave Maria Radio. He has been a guest on EWTN’s *Mother Angelica Live* and *Life on the Rock* programs. He has hosted three television series for EWTN, covering topics such as the commandments of Catholic family living, that is, for husband and father; for wife and mother; of children and teens; and for those who struggle with scrupulosity. He is currently host of the EWTN series entitled *The Crux of the Matter*.
